| The minor in Communication Technology provides students with an understanding of the impact of communication technology on society and an introduction to basic skills required for designing websites and other interactive media. | Required for graduation No <u>Credit hours required</u> A minimum of 12. 1000 level courses shall not be counted in the minor. At least 6 credit hours must be at the 3000-level or above. |
| The Communication Technology minor requires the completion of at least four courses for a minimum of 12 credits, including one foundational course. Upon completion of the minor, students should file the Minor with a college or school counselor. Any variation from the program described below needs the approval of the Director of Undergraduate Studies. Students may request approval of a minor variation by filing a petition through the School of Communication Advising Office. | <u>Transfer and EM credit hours allowed</u> A student is permitted to count up to 6 total hours of transfer credit and/or credit by examination. <u>Overlap with the GE</u> A student is permitted to overlap up to 6 credit hours between the GE and the minor. <u>Overlap with the major and additional minor(s)</u> The minor must be in a different subject than the major. The minor must contain a minimum of 12 hours distinct from the major and/or additional minor(s). |
